- Adoration: Rendering to God the honor, respect, glory, and love due His holy majesty in light of how worthy he is
- Confession: Affirming and Agreeing with God's perspective and revelation
- Thanksgiving: Response of gratitude for God's person and His works, as we observe/consider/remember how God has intersected with and ruled over our lives and the lives of others.

The Marian Contraction

- Working Definition: Making requests of God, that align themselves to His nature, character, word, and will, in recognition of His ability to meet what we require.
 - o Do not ask for what is in contrast to God's nature
 - o Understand the difference between desires and needs
 - e Understand that you cannot provide your needs

- o Petitions: Asking God what is needed
- o Intercession: Asking on behalf of others
- o Questions: Seeking to understand
- o Imprecations: Asking for God's judgment upon sin

TEELCOMS

- o Often in times of trial (Jam. 1:5-7)
- o Content can concern everything (1 Pet. 5:7)
- o Don't beat around the bush (Matt. 6:10-12; 25-32)
- Involving physical (Matt. 14:30), spiritual needs (Mk. 9:24),
 or both (2 Cor. 12:7-9)
- Pray and submit (2 Cor. 12:7-9) vs. once and done (1 Thess. 5:17)
- o Conducted in holiness (1 Tim. 2:8)
- o Within the will of God (In. 14:13-14)

- o Safety for believers among the heathen (Gen. 18)
- o God's enabling of conception (Gen. 26:21)
- o The repentance from bad theology (Job 42)
- o Grace for people in rebellion (Ex. 32)

- Prayer for rulers to either convert or leave believers in peace (1 Tim. 2:1-2)

Impracations.

- "Let the wicked fall into their own nets, while I pass by" -Ps. 141:10
- "And in Your lovingkindness, cut off my enemies and destroy all those who afflict my soul, for I am Your servant" - Ps. 143:12
- o Imprecations # requests for personal vindication
- Imprecations = requests for God's righteous judgment upon sin
 - e All sin receives wrath (upon calvary or in hell)
 - e How can one pray imprecations in "Jesus' name"?

- o Prayers for Preservation (vv. 1-5)
- o Prayers Based on Precedence (vv. 6-8)
- @ Prayers of Imprecation and Confidence (vv. 9-13)

Prayers for Protection

- o Prayer for removal and protection (vv. 1-3)
 - Action: "Rescue" (אובר) = to removed/pull out "Preserve" (נצר) = to protect
 - o Source: "evil" (ער) and "violent" (סמח) men
 - o Reason: They constantly planning and plotting evil and violence
- o Prayer for supervision and protection (vv. 4-5)
 - Action: "Keep" (שמר) = to watch/guard/oversee "Preserve" (נצר) = to protect
 - o Source: "evil" (γη) hands and violent (DDD) men
 - o Reason: They are coming for me

Prayers Based on Precedence

- a Request from a position of submission (v. 6)
 - o Position of submission (v. 6a)
 - o Request to be heard (v. 6b)
- o Request from a position of precedence (vv. 7-8)
 - o Submission restated (v. 7a)
 - o Precedence stated (v. 7b)
 - o Request made (v. 8)

Imprecations & Confidence

- o Righteous Imprecations (vv. 9-11)
 - @ Precedence (v. 9a): YHWH does not protect their head
 - @ Request (vv. 9b-11): May they receive justice from YHWH
- o Confessions of Confidence (vv. 12-13)
 - a Confidence in YHWH's plan
 - e Confession of YHWH's name
 - o Anticipation of YHWH's presence

COMELS COM

- o David prays in the midst of real physical problems
 - o He wants the situation to end
 - e He asks to be removed from danger
- e David prays within the will of God
 - e He knows what and who he is in God's plan
- o David prays from the perspective of God's glory
 - e knowing that God does not desire the wicked to endure
 - o Knowing that justice will be served
 - e knowing that God's plan will come to fruition
