This weekend, we'll center our hearts around what Christians call Palm Sunday! Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week, commemorating Jesus Christ's triumphant entry into Jerusalem. This significant event symbolizes the anticipation of Jesus' eventual crucifixion and resurrection, a central focus of Christian faith. Let's lean in and see what God has for us through His Word.

Key Passage: Matthew 21; John 12; Luke 19

Questions for Reflection and Discussion

<u>Grow</u>

Reflecting on the Palm Sunday story, what significance do you think the crowds placing palm branches before Jesus held? How might their actions relate to our own worship and acknowledgment of Christ today?

In considering Jesus' entry into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, what emotions do you think He might have experienced knowing the events that would unfold later in the week? How does His response to the crowds and the city challenge us to approach challenges and adversity in our own lives?

The events of Palm Sunday reveal contrasts in people's responses to Jesus, from adoration to rejection. How can we ensure that our own hearts remain aligned with the true nature of Christ, even in the face of societal pressures or conflicting beliefs?

<u>Go</u>

Palm Sunday serves as a reminder of Jesus' humility and willingness to fulfill God's plan, even unto death. How can we emulate Jesus' humility and obedience in our daily lives, particularly when faced with difficult circumstances or decisions?

Discuss practical ways we can observe Palm Sunday beyond mere tradition, incorporating its themes of humility, triumph, and anticipation into our daily walk with Christ.

Take time to pray this week for someone in your life who needs to hear the message of the resurrection of Jesus. Pray that God would give you the boldness to invite them to church on Easter Sunday!
