

Sermon Summary

As we enter our Christmas at The Hills season, each campus will unpack varying topics around the season of Christmas and the birth of Jesus. This week, Pastor Nathan will dive into Exodus 3 where God reveals himself to Moses in a burning bush instructing Moses to lead the Israelites out of their bondage in Egypt. We'll connect this encounter to the arrival of Jesus in the New Testament and see how Jesus' arrival also sets us free from our bondage.

Key Passage: Exodus 3:1-15

Questions for Reflection and Discussion

<u>Grow</u>

In Exodus 3:14, God reveals His name as "I AM WHO I AM." What significance does this name have, and how does it shape our understanding of God?

How does God's self-revelation in this chapter compare to how people might perceive or define God in the world today?

Moses initially hesitates and gives several excuses when God calls him. Why do you think Moses responds this way? Can you relate to any of his concerns in your own life?

<u>Go</u>

God promises to be with Moses throughout the journey. How does the assurance of God's presence impact Moses, and how can it provide comfort and guidance in our own lives?

Share personal experiences of times when obedience to God's call led to growth or transformation.

Are there specific promises from God's Word that you find particularly encouraging or challenging?
