

Psalm 100: All Campus Discussion Guide

Sermon Summary

There are so many ways that God has showed His love for us. We see His love in the things He created for us, in the Bible He's given us, and most importantly, by the gift of His only Son that He sent to die for our sin. However, this week's sermon discusses one of the ways that we can, in turn, show our love for God. Of course, there are many ways that we can show God our love toward Him, but Psalm 100 talks about one specific way we can show love to our Lord—through our worship.

Key Passage: Psalm 100

Questions for Reflection and Discussion

Grow

God's people are expected to praise Him and give Him thanks. Do you feel you understand what it means to give God worship? Talk about that.

It's been said that every person, regardless of personal beliefs or religious background, is a worshipper. We all worship something. Do you concur with that? Discuss that idea.

Psalm 100 tells us that a way in which we can worship God is by serving. What does it mean to serve God?

Go

In this season of life, do you find it easy to worship joyfully? Why do you think that is?

Why should we be grateful to God? Give specific reasons and specific blessings for which our group should be grateful.

Spend some time with your group worshipping the Lord for who He is through prayer and/or song.
