MINDSETS: A MISSION MINDSET

DISCUSSION GUIDE

SUMMARY:

As we continue in our "Mindset Series," we examine what it looks like for us to have a mission mindset. The Scriptures say that Jesus came to earth on a mission: To seek out and to save all who were lost. This is the mission He has called us to as well: To love Him and to show and tell of His love to others.

Key Passage: John 9:1-11

Be sure to read this Scripture passage together before you proceed to the "Grow" section of our study.

QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION AND DISCUSSION

KNOW: Spend some time finding out how everyone's week has gone.

The questions in this section provide a guide for connectivity; feel free to approach this part of your group time organically over a meal or "connection" activity or with questions appropriate to your context.

What is something that you are thankful for this week?

What is something that is causing you stress or concern this week?

Who in your life is in need of prayer, physical help, or emotional encouragement right now?

GROW: Grow in the Lord as you engage His Word together.

Because we're prone to want our own way and our own personal preferences, we can tend to be more selfish (inward), than missional (outward). What are some ways we can combat this and have a mission mindset like Jesus had while He was here on earth?

Talk about the difference of just seeing Jesus as a "Band-Aid" for our spiritual problems, versus seeing Him as our complete and only hope of salvation.

How does the blind man serve as a witness and evidence to the work of redemption in this story? When asked how he sees, what does he say in John 9:11?

GO: Talk through ways you can put what you've learned into practice.

Pastor Brett talked about our personal salvation testimony this week. Do you have a testimony of when you gave your life and heart totally to Christ that you can verbally articulate? Rehearse that to yourself and to your friends.

In reference to Luke 10:27, Pastor Brett said that Jesus was way more about people than philosophy. Talk about what he meant by that.
