# **VISION SUNDAY: DISCUSSION GUIDE**

### **SUMMARY:**

The Scriptures teach us that Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever! All other things change over time, but we can be confident that Jesus, our God, never will. The reality is that change is simply a part of life. In a world that is ever-changing, often at break-neck speed, it's amazingly reassuring to know that we worship a perfect, wonderful, gracious Savior who will never change!

## **QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION AND DISCUSSION**

## KNOW: Spend some time finding out how everyone's week has gone.

The questions in this section provide a guide for connectivity; feel free to approach this part of your group time organically over a meal or "connection" activity or with questions appropriate to your context.

What is something that you are thankful for this week?

What is something that is causing you stress or concern this week?

Who in your life is in need of prayer, physical help, or emotional encouragement right now?

#### GROW: Grow in the Lord as you engage His Word together.

God calls us to imitate Him by being faithful in the way we show love to others (Hebrews 13:1-4). Share some specific (maybe even creative) ways we can be loving and hospitable to others—even to those who we may feel are not easy to love.

Century after century, the church is called to faithfully serve the same, unchanging God. Yet, the reality is, the world we are sent to reach is constantly changing. Discuss the importance of reaching this generation with the gospel.

Read Philippians 4:19 (NLT), according to that text, how can we know that our every need in Jesus is met?

#### GO: Talk through ways you can put what you've learned into practice.

How does the truth that God never changes shape your theology and sociology?

What are the implications of God being changeless? How does His constant love and faithfulness toward you make you feel?

Is there someone in your life that has not experienced the same wonder working power of Jesus? Take time to pray for them and ask God to give you opportunities to share the gospel with them.
