## <u>Grow</u>

Jeremiah 1:5 says, "Before I created you in the womb I knew you; before you were born I set you apart." What does this verse mean to you? Do you believe what the Bible teaches here—that life begins in the womb?

God doesn't expect parents to raise perfect kids. Although, He does want us to help our children to flesh out what it looks like to make the most of their God-given abilities and desires. If you have children/grandchildren, talk about what you feel your spiritual responsibilities are towards your children.

Psalm 127 seems to unpack for us the truth that we have to relinquish control of the children in our lives and let God be in charge. What are your thoughts/takeaways from this Psalm?

## Go

Are there rhythms that you have created with your children to prioritize intimacy with God? Share them with the group.

What would you say to a couple struggling with an unwanted pregnancy? What would you say to a couple struggling to raise their children?
