# **DISCUSSION GUIDE**

#### SUMMARY:

As we continue our series, Jesus is, we will look at the fact that Jesus is The Answer. Jesus tells us not to be overwhelmed or troubled. He calls us to remain close to him in his presence. The Jesus way, connected to the Jesus truth, leads to the Jesus life. And so, the answer to every problem we face is Jesus, His presence, and activity.

# QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION AND DISCUSSION

### KNOW: Spend some time finding out how everyone's week has gone.

The questions in this section provide a guide for connectivity; feel free to approach this part of your group time organically over a meal or "connection" activity or with questions appropriate to your context.

What is something that you are thankful for this week?

What is something that is causing you stress or concern this week?

Who in your life is in need of prayer, physical help, or emotional encouragement right now?

### GROW: Grow in the Lord as you engage His Word together.

Jesus states that He is the way, the truth, and the life. What is the significance of each of these terms? What is Jesus trying to convey to His disciples about why He came and what He offered people?

The second half of verse 6 says, "no one can come to the father except through me." This can sound exclusive and narrow in our multi-faith society. What do you think Jesus wanted to communicate by saying this? Consider especially the surrounding context.

Based on today's study, how would you respond to someone who believes Jesus is a great teacher, but not truly God?

## GO: Talk through ways you can put what you've learned into practice.

In the very first verse of this passage, Jesus gives a simple remedy for a troubled heart. Where in your life is your heart troubled and how can trusting God and Jesus bring peace?

Do you remember when Jesus came into your life and showed you that He is the way and the truth? Share your testimony with the group.

Do you have a friend who needs to hear about Jesus, the giver of life? Take time to pray for them and ask God to give you opportunities to share the gospel with them.
