

## Week 44

Week Forty-four Memory Verse – “All things come from You, and from Your hand we have given You.” 1 Chronicles 29 v 14

1. 1 Chronicles 24-25

Question – We sometimes think of worship as simply a minor part of the Sunday service (with the “important part” being the preaching. Chapter 25 mentions that musicians were selected by “David and the commanders of the army” (25 v 1). What does the inclusion of worship leaders in Israel’s army say about the importance of worshiping God?

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2. 1 Chronicles 26-27

Question – 27 v 24 speaks of the wrath of the LORD which came upon Israel because of David counting the fighting men (2 Samuel 24). Why did the Father desire to wean Israel from its dependence upon its army?

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3. 1 Chronicles 28-29

Question - Chapter 29 v 14 reads, “all things come from You (God), and from Your hand we have given you.” How does knowing that everything that we give God (be it our talents, time, or finances) has its origin in Him make giving of those gifts back to Him easier?

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4. 2 Chronicles 1-3

Question – Solomon built the temple “in Jerusalem on Mount Moriah.” As you reference Genesis 22 v 2, what is the significance of this particular mountain?

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5. 2 Chronicles 4-5

Question – The song sung at the dedication of Solomon’s temple includes the refrain, “His lovingkindness is everlasting” (5 v 13). In what ways has the LORD demonstrated His lovingkindness to you and how will He continue to do so throughout eternity?

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
