GROUP DISCUSSION

- READ John 10:1-10 -

1. What does Jesus mean when He claims to be the door for the sheep?

2. Do you look to Jesus as The Door to salvation? How has Jesus provided you with an invitation to enter the Kingdom? How has He been a means of separation from the evils of the world? How has He been a means of safety?

- READ John 10:11-18

3. Verse 11 says "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep." Jesus is so committed to us, that He laid down His for ours! What is your reaction to this type of commitment shown by Jesus?

4. Verse 14 and 15 say "I am the good shepherd. I know my own and my own know me, 15 just as the Father knows me and I know the Father..." Did you know that if you allow Jesus to be your shepherd, you will have a connection with Him? And through Jesus, you will have a connection with The Father. How have you made Jesus the shepherd of your life? What areas of your life do you still need to turn over to Him?

5. In verse 18, Jesus said that he laid down His life on his own accord. That means He chose to do it! What kind of response should we have as Christians to this act from Jesus?

6. The point of this week is to believe these claims that Jesus has made. Do you fully believe that Jesus is the Door, the Good Shepherd, and one with God? Is there anything else in your life that stands in the way and serves as one of these claims instead of Jesus? What do you need to do to fully surrender to Jesus right now?
