GROUP DISCUSSION

- READ John 17:1-10 -

1. As Jesus starts His prayer, what does He say about Himself? Why is this important? (v1--He is the Son of God, His goal is to glorify the Father; v2--He has the authority over all flesh, he has authority to give eternal life; v3—Jesus is the Word of God, everything the Father wants the world to know in a Person; v4—Jesus is holy and perfect; v5—He is eternal; v6—Jesus is fully God and fully man; v10—Jesus and the Father are one)

2. What promise(s) does Jesus offer to all believers in these verses? (Jesus promises eternal life, that we are God's children and always have been. We are safe and secure in God's family.)

3. Who and what are you praying for right now? (Answers may vary - Leaders: lean into the answers to better understand the prayer request. Also, Pray for the group before moving on.)

- READ John 17:11-19 -

4. What does it mean for us to be in the world (v11), but not of the world (v14)? How do we do that? (Our current circumstances don't define our eternal hope. We live among believers and non-believers alike, but we are called to live differently. Believers reject what the world hopes and strives for because we have an eternal hope that leads us to not strive, but just abide in Him!)

- READ John 17:20-26 -

5. Who is Jesus praying for in these verses? What is Jesus praying for? (Jesus is praying for the disciples who are with him at this time and for all future disciples, including you and me. Jesus is also praying for our "one-mores". Jesus is praying for unity in his Church and that our love for each other will be seen by the world.)

6. How is God calling you to be an answer to Jesus' prayer, today? (Answers may vary.)
