RELATIONAL CONNECT & CHECK-IN

- What's the funniest or worst roommate interaction you've ever had? Maybe it was in college...at home as kids...sharing a hotel room...etc.

GROUP DISCUSSION

Read Luke 11:21-27 as a group and share any immediate things that stick out to you.

- 1. Why is it important for believers to acknowledge the reality of spiritual influence, without slipping into fear? Do you believe in it, personally? What have or haven't you experienced that makes you believe one way or another?
- 2. This week, Matt talked about the different types of demonic influence: oppression, possession, and occupation. How would you explain the differences? Was any of this new information for you?
- 3. What are some of the "flaming darts" (lies & temptations) the enemy uses most often in your life? (See Ephesians 6:16) How do those darts affect you?
- 4. Once you can decipher tone, you can more easily distinguish who's voice is speaking to you. Remember, the enemy speaks in tones of despair. The Holy Spirit speaks hope and life. Describe a time in your life when you heard the voice and looking back now can tell who it was speaking to you. How does recognizing the tone of the Accuser help us discern what's not from God? (Bonus: Read John 10 together)
- 5. Why do you think "submit to God" is listed before "resist the devil" in James 4:7 (Hint: Oftentimes, we're quick to "resist" without actually surrendering to God. We can only resist on our own for so long.)
- 6. What are some tangible ways believers can support each other when spiritual oppression feels heavy or confusing?
- 7. What's one truth from Scripture that directly answers a lie you've been believing? (Romans 8:31–39 is a great start.)

ACTION STEP

Identify one specific **lie** you've believed recently. Write it down. Then, write one **truth from Scripture** that answers it (Romans 8, Ephesians 1, 2 Corinthians 10). Each day this week, pray: "Jesus, fill this room. I belong to You alone."

Lastly: How can we pray as a group for you as a group? Be honest...
