G R O U P D I S C U S S I O N

- Read 1 Peter 1:1-3 -

1. How does Peter introduce himself in this letter? Why is that important? (Peter identifies himself as a Servant first and THEN an Apostle. He was more committed to who he was in Christ than making sure others knew how big of a deal he was. If serving is beneath you, leading is beyond you.)

2. Peter talks about OBTAINING faith. What are the differing understandings of this in today's church culture? (Matt talked about the difference between Justification - Being made right in the eyes of God because of Jesus' blood, and Sanctification - Being set apart for Holy purposes. It's easy to slip into the trap of believing good works obtains you faith and justification...but in reality, good works are what you do as a result of having been justified already. Those that simply believe and follow Jesus have "obtained faith" through Christ's work atoning work alone.)

3. What's the difference between knowing "about" God and actually knowing Him? How have you seen yourself or others get this wrong? (Answers may vary.)

- Read 1 Peter 1:4 -

4. God has made 7487 promises to mankind. Can you recall any? What are some of your favorites? (Answers may vary. **Having trouble coming up with some? Look at God's Word...Ask the Holy Spirit to bring them to mind....or if you're still struggling to come up with some, Google it!)

- Read 1 Peter 1:5-9 -

5. Peter lists out 7 supplements to a foundational faith. Walk through each one and talk about what they mean to you. After considering each of them, do you find yourself growing in them...or is your Christian walk ineffective and unfruitful. Be honest. What steps can you take today to grow in those? (Answers may vary.)
