We grieve the Holy Spirit when we turn inward as a church and allowing the enemy to cause divisions in the church. How can we protect unity at Mosaic? (Corresponding passage: Romans 16:17-20)

Matt said, "Cynicism and Criticism are not spiritual discernment...they're demonic". What do you think he meant by that?

Read Romans 8:11. What does this passage mean? Does this truth do anything within you?

Read 2 Timothy 1:6-7. We're either grieving the Spirit or we're stoking the Holy Spirit's fire in us? How do we fan into flame the gift of God?

If you could sum up tonight's study in one sentence, what would it be?

KEY PRINCIPLES

There's a distinct difference between a life of following the Holy Spirit vs grieving Him. God isn't looking for perfect people...He's just asking that we obey what He's called us to. It's important to understand that when God is wanting to do HUGE things in and through you, the evil one is trying to thwart those plans...stay alert!
