## **G R O U P D I S C U S S I O N**

- READ John 2:13-25

- 1. What do you think about when you think about Jesus?** (Remember AW Tozers quote: The most-important thing about you is what you think about when you think about God.)
- 2. What is the problem at the temple? How would you summarize the heart of the problem?** (*Jesus saw how His people were being exploited by the very system that was supposed to point people to the Savior.*)
- 3. How is Jesus displaying righteous anger? What is the difference between righteous and unrighteous anger? Is there even a difference?** (*Are we upset because our souls hunger and thirst for righteousness (Matthew 5:6) or because we are personally offended or inconvenienced (James 4:1)? Anger does not happen to us, it's something that is inside of us.*)
- 4. How were the Gentiles being pushed out of the Temple? How do unbelievers (or newer Christians) get "pushed" out of the church today?**
- 5. Jesus wants to remove all obstacles from the relationship He desires to have with you. What part of your life are you trying to control and need to surrender to Him?** (*Answers will vary*)
- 6. What do you suppose happens in your soul and your relationship with Jesus when you have righteous anger and do nothing about it?** (*We are often afraid of the consequences of taking bold faith actions but fail to consider the impact to our soul when we don't take action.*)

## **A C T I O N S T E P**

This week in your quiet time consider all the things that make you angry...both righteous and unrighteous. Write them down. Ask God to show you things that make you angry which you may have not considered before.

**After writing your list pray through them, asking God to show you which items:**

- Reveal the kingdom of you (Unrighteous)
- Reveal the kingdom of God (Righteous)

**Once you've identified what angers you, surrender your unrighteous anger to God.**

Step towards righteous anger by taking a step towards loving all people and making room in your life for others who need the saving faith that you've found!
