RELATIONAL CONNECT & CHECK-IN

What's something that looked so good on the outside (the surface) but ultimately left you feeling unsatisfied?

GROUP DISCUSSION

Read Hebrews 11:23-29 Share anything that immediately resonates w/ you. Then go read Moses' story: **Exodus 1-3**.

1. Hebrews 11:27 says Moses endured "as seeing him who is invisible." What does it practically mean to live as though the unseen God is more real than visible circumstances?
2. Moses left Egypt before he knew how the story would unfold. What does that teach us about obedience and outcomes? (Compare Proverbs 3:5-6.) How do we apply this?
3. Why does it seem that God rarely reveals the full plan before calling us to move?
4. Egypt represented power, comfort, identity, and security. Which of those is hardest for you to surrender? Why?
5. How do we distinguish between enjoying God's gifts and worshipping them?
6. The sermon highlighted Revelation and Illumination. How do Psalm 19 and John 16:13 help us understand how God speaks today?
7. If Scripture is the closed canon (not open for adding/subtracting/editing), how should we evaluate impressions, feelings, or perceived "words from God" from others?
8. How would you respond to someone who says, "If God has wrath, He can't be good"?
9. Is salvation something we walk through once (Passover), or something we continue living out daily? How does sanctification connect to this?
10. What's one "Egypt" believers today commonly refuse to leave? Why? How can we lovingly challenge each other if we see someone clinging to Egypt?
11. Summarize this week's message in one sentence.

ACTION STEP

If you know there is unconfessed sin dulling your spiritual sensitivity, don't delay. Confess it specifically. Repent intentionally. Share it with a trusted believer if needed (James 5:16).

Position yourself to hear God clearly again!
