Share a win...big or small! What is God doing in your life? Where have you struggled in your walk over the last few weeks?

GROUP DISCUSSION

- READ John 8:1-11 -
- 1. How did Jesus offer both truth and grace in these verses? (Jesus offers us the same thing. He comes down to her and our level. Jesus offers the truth when he did not find fault in the law and did not excuse anyone's guilt. He extends grace when he tells the woman, "Neither do I condemn you; go, and from now on sin no more.")
- 2. Where do you struggle the most when it comes to truth and grace? How can you grow in this area? (We can struggle with recognizing our own sinful habits or seeing what is true about our current situation. Other times we may struggle with giving ourselves enough grace, trusting we are a child of God. Often we struggle with offering up truth and grace, out of love, to those God has placed in our lives.)
- Read 1 Corinthians 6:9-20 -
- **3.** What is the most difficult or impactful thing you heard in the sermon regarding these verses? (Answers may vary. Leaders offer space and silence to let everyone time to be comforted by the Lord before they speak. Be ready to STOP and PRAY!)
- READ John 8:10-11 & Romans 8:1 -
- 4. How does Jesus model what it means to "Love All People"? What is one way you can show Jesus' love to someone who may feel condemned and unfit for use this week? (Answers may vary.)
- 5. Think about Christ's forgiveness of your past sins...all of them! When you reflect on Jesus coming not to condemn, but to save the world through offering eternal life, what do you think about first and why? (Answers may vary. Jesus tells the woman that she is to, "go then, and sin no more." Remember that Christ's favor offered to us in the gift of salvation, and the forgiveness of past sins is the same power that allows us the strength to sin no more.)

As a Disciple of Jesus, we know that we're only saved by the gift of grace, through faith in Jesus. We didn't earn it. But now that we have it, we are called to share it. BEFORE YOU WRAP YOUR TIME TOGETHER TODAY:

- Take the time to IDENTIFY someone that God has laid on your heart to reach for the Gospel.
- Partner up and pray for each of your "One"(s).
- Pray specifically for an opportunity to invite your "One" to worship with you.
- Pray for boldness and courage to extend that invitation
- Text your prayer partner later in the week after you've invited your "One".
