GROUP DISCUSSION

Read Jonah 3 as a group and share any immediate things that stick out to you.

- 1. God called Jonah a second time to go to Ninevah...and this time he went. Can you think of a time when God called you to do something, you ignored and it didn't go well. Did He ask a second time? Did you obey? Share what that experience was like.
- 2. The word "overthrown" can mean "completely changed." Where have you seen God overturn something in your life for good?
- 3. Verse 5: "The people of Nineveh believed God." Matt said that "the evidence of belief in God is repentance....belief does something". What are your thoughts on this?
- 4. The king of Nineveh gets off his throne and repents. What "thrones" in your life are the hardest to get off. Where might you need to step down from?
- 5. "God is the God of another chance." What does that stir in you? Where do you personally need to receive that today? Where is He inviting you to extend it to others?
- 6. Jonah struggled to want mercy for his enemies. Who is hard for you to pray for? What helps align your heart with God's heart? (Preview of ch. 4 theme)
- 7. Our culture has recently shifted (over the last few weeks). What have you sensed when it comes to matters of faith? How does this encourage you?

ACTION STEP

Our faith is lived "outside the walls." What's one tangible way your group can bless someone outside this month? Brainstorm and pick one to do this month!
