RELATIONAL CONNECT & CHECK-IN

What's a decision you made in life that later proved to be far more valuable...or far more costly... than you expected?

GROUP DISCUSSION

Read Hebrews 11:23-26 Share anything that immediately resonates w/ you. Then go read Moses' story: **Exodus 1-3**.

1. What stands out to you most about Moses' parents' faith? (v23)
2. The text says they were "not afraid of the king's edict." What fears tend to pressure our faith in today's culture...both inside and outside the church?
3. What's the difference between bold faith and reckless foolishness?
4. Where in your life have you been tempted to label something as "faith" that might actually be motivated by selfish ambition, pride or greed?
5. Think about your home, or the home you were raised in. What rhythms visibly communicated that Jesus is valuable? Or were there other things that took His place
6. Sin is fleeting. Can you think of a time when something sinful promised satisfaction but left you empty? If you're comfortable, share it with the group. Odds are, someone else has wrestled with the same thing!
7. Moses chose mistreatment (being with God's people) over pleasure (staying in Pharaoh's family). If you were in his shoes, would you make that same choice? Why?
8. How can we intentionally live for what lasts instead of what fades?
9. What desire in your life might be carrying too much weight right now?
10. Who in your life has permission to lovingly point out your blind spots?
11. If you listed your recent choices & decisions, what would they reveal you value most?
12. If Jesus truly is better than anything this world offers, what change would that belief produce in your life this week? What course corrections would you need to make?

ACTION STEP

Practice the pause. Before making any significant decision this week, pause and ask: Is this fleeting or eternal? Is this feeding my flesh or strengthening my faith? Am I choosing comfortable, sinful Egypt or am I intentionally choosing Jesus...b/c I believe He is better?

Lastly: How can we pray as a group for you as a group? Be honest...
