RELATIONAL CONNECT & CHECK-IN

If you received an unexpected gift from someone this week, what would be your natural first reaction: immediately calling to say thank you, texting later, or just enjoying the gift and moving on? Be honest!

GROUP DISCUSSION

Read Luke 17:11-19 as a group. Share anything that immediately stands out to you.

- 1) Which person in this story do you honestly relate to most right now—the desperate leper crying out, the healed leper who returned, or the nine who kept moving? Why?**
- 2) Why do you think it's often easier to ask God for help than to slow down and worship Him after He answers?**
- 3) The sermon challenged us to seek God's face, not just His hand. What does that difference practically look like in everyday life?**
- 4) The lepers obeyed Jesus before they saw the miracle happen. Why is obedience before understanding so difficult for us?**
- 5) In Sunday's message, Matt described sin as "spiritual leprosy." In what ways does sin isolate people, numb people, or slowly damage their lives?**
- 6) "I don't come to church to worship...I come worshiping to church." What's the difference between those two mindsets?**
- 7) If someone looked at your schedule, stress, spending, and attention this past month...what would they conclude matters most to you?** (Be honest. Extra Credit: Maybe ask someone to, in love, answer that question for you.)
- 8) Read 1 Peter 2:9-10. Does this do anything inside of you? Does it inspire a deeper worship?**

ACTION STEP

This week, every time you notice a blessing, answered prayer, provision, or moment of joy... pause before moving on. Don't just acknowledge the gift. Turn your attention back to the Giver.
