RELATIONAL CONNECT & CHECK-IN

- What's one move, change, or decision in your life that felt scary at first—but later proved to be worth it?

GROUP DISCUSSION

Read Hebrews 11:8-16. Share anything that immediately resonates w/ you.

- 1. When you hear that Abraham went “not knowing where he was going,” what emotion does that stir in you—excitement, fear, resistance, or something else? Why? (This reveals our heart’s posture towards faith.)**
- 2. What details would you want God to clarify before you said yes to a major calling? Be specific. (Leader: Push past “everything.” Ask for examples.)**
- 3. Have you ever followed God into something that didn’t pay off the way you expected on this side of eternity? How did that affect your faith? (Leader: Normalize disappointment without fixing it.)**
- 4. Read Isaiah 55:8-9 as a group. Where have you seen that to be true in yours or someone else’s life? Does this truth help grow your faith?**
- 5. “Earthly cities have no foundation.” Where have you personally seen something you trusted eventually fail you? (Career, people, money, certainty, health, plans.)**
- 6. Why is it easier to see unstable foundations in other people’s lives than in our own? (This one creates self-awareness.)**
- 7. Read Matthew 7:24-27. How can you tell when something *feels* like a strong foundation but actually isn’t? What are some practical ways we can help each other in this?**
- 8. If “faith pleases God”, what do you think displeases Him more: doubt or refusal to follow Him?**

ACTION STEP

Each morning this week, pray this simple prayer: ***“God, my yes is on the table...before I know the details.”*** Pay attention to what fears or resistance surface, and bring those honestly to God.
