Free Will	Humans have genuine free will, enabled by prevenient grace to choose or reject God	Human will is bound by sin; only those elected by God can respond to grace
Grace	Grace is resistible—God offers it to all, but people can reject it	Grace is <i>irresistible</i> —those God chooses will respond and be saved
Atonement	Universal atonement—Christ died for all people	Limited atonement—Christ died only for the elect
Election	Based on God's foreknowledge of who would freely choose Him	Unconditional—God chooses whom to save apart from anything they do
Perseverance	Believers must continue in faith; salvation can be lost through willful rejection	True believers will persevere to the end; if they fall away, they were never saved
Assurance	Conditional—based on ongoing faith and obedience	Strong—based on God's unchanging promise and sovereign will
Sanctification	Emphasizes entire sanctification and holy living as a second work of grace	Sanctification is progressive and inevitable for the elect
