Justification - Declared right before God

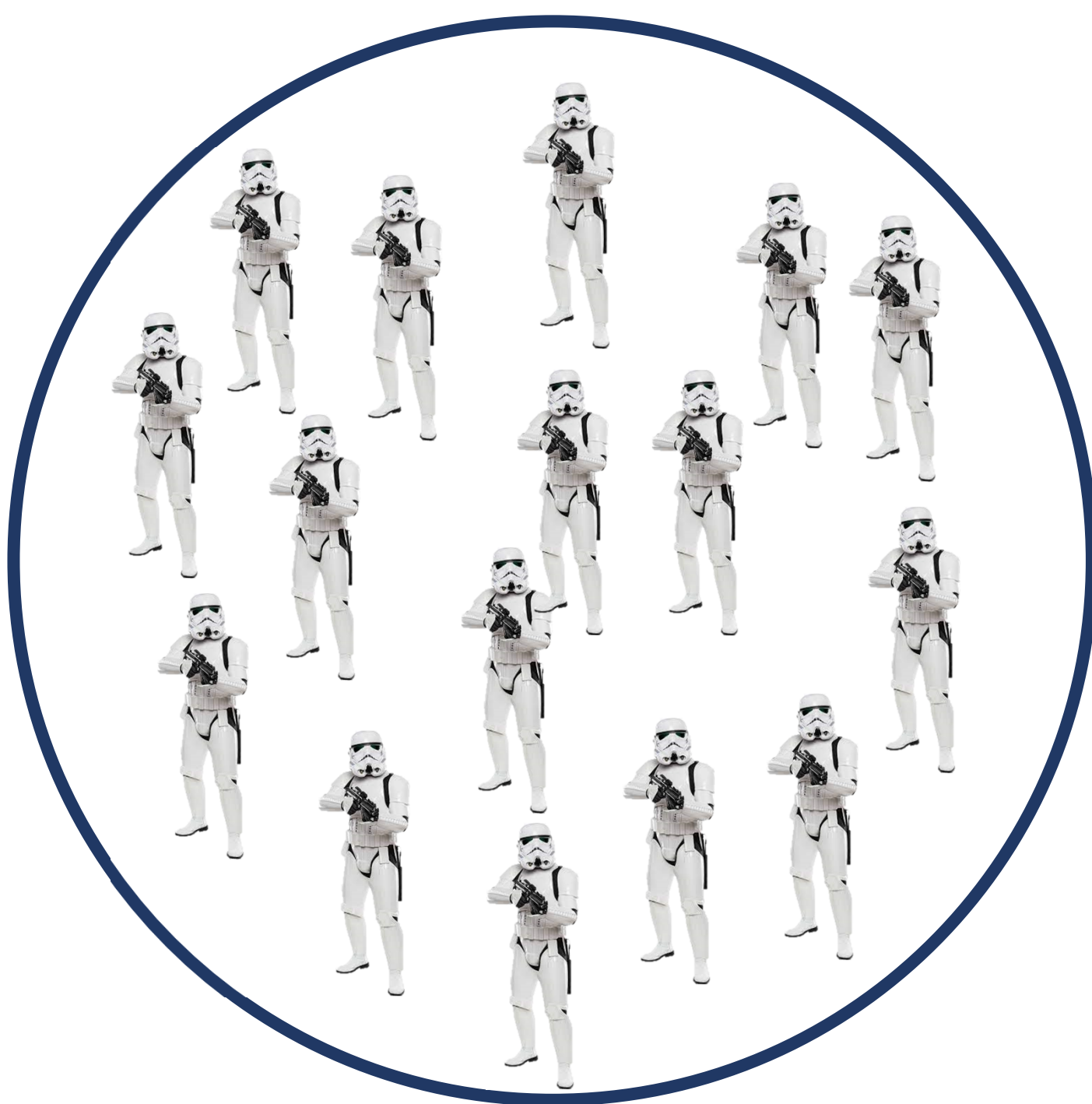
Salvation from the Penalty of Sin

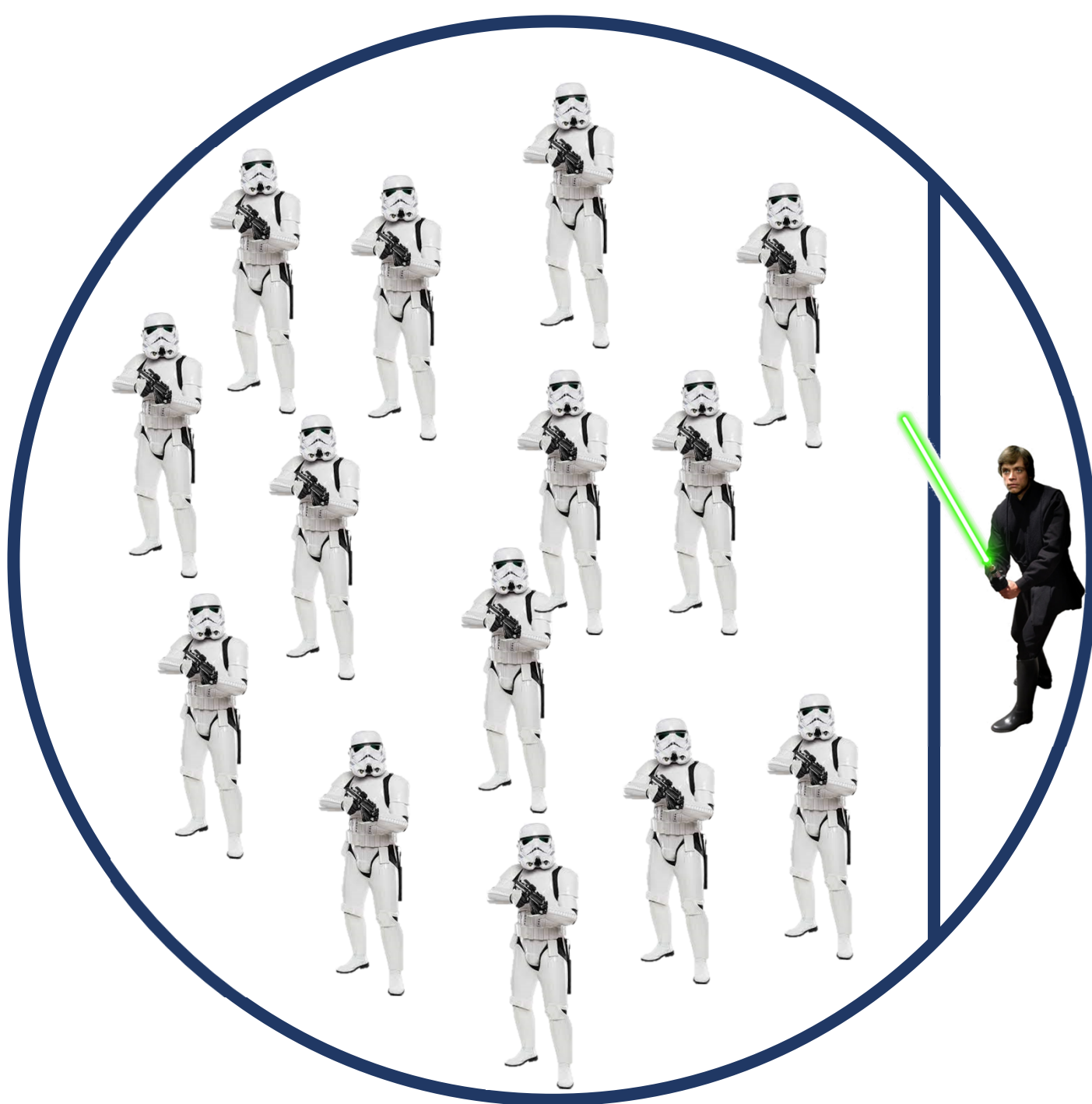
Sanctification - being set apart

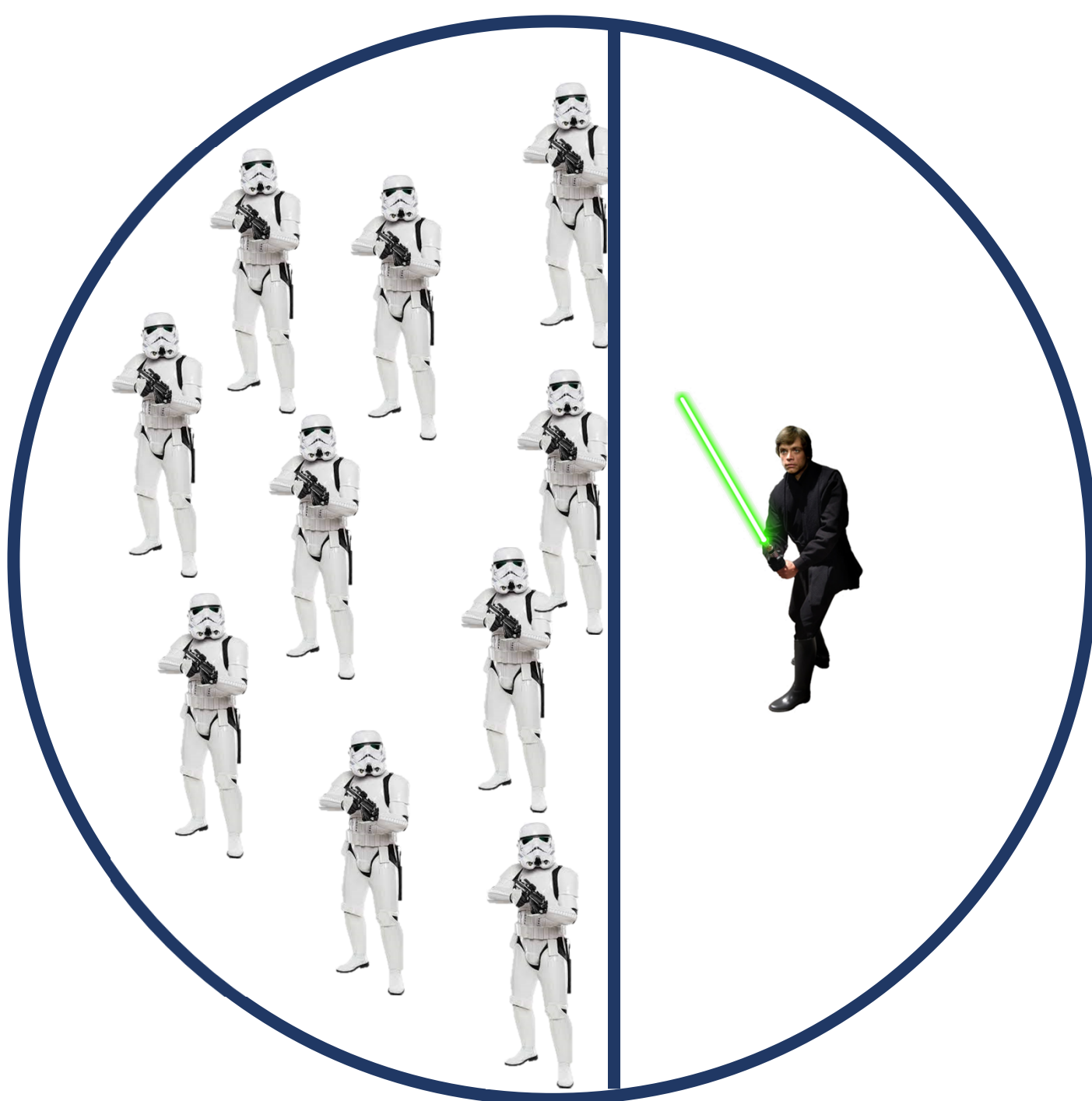
Salvation from the power of sin

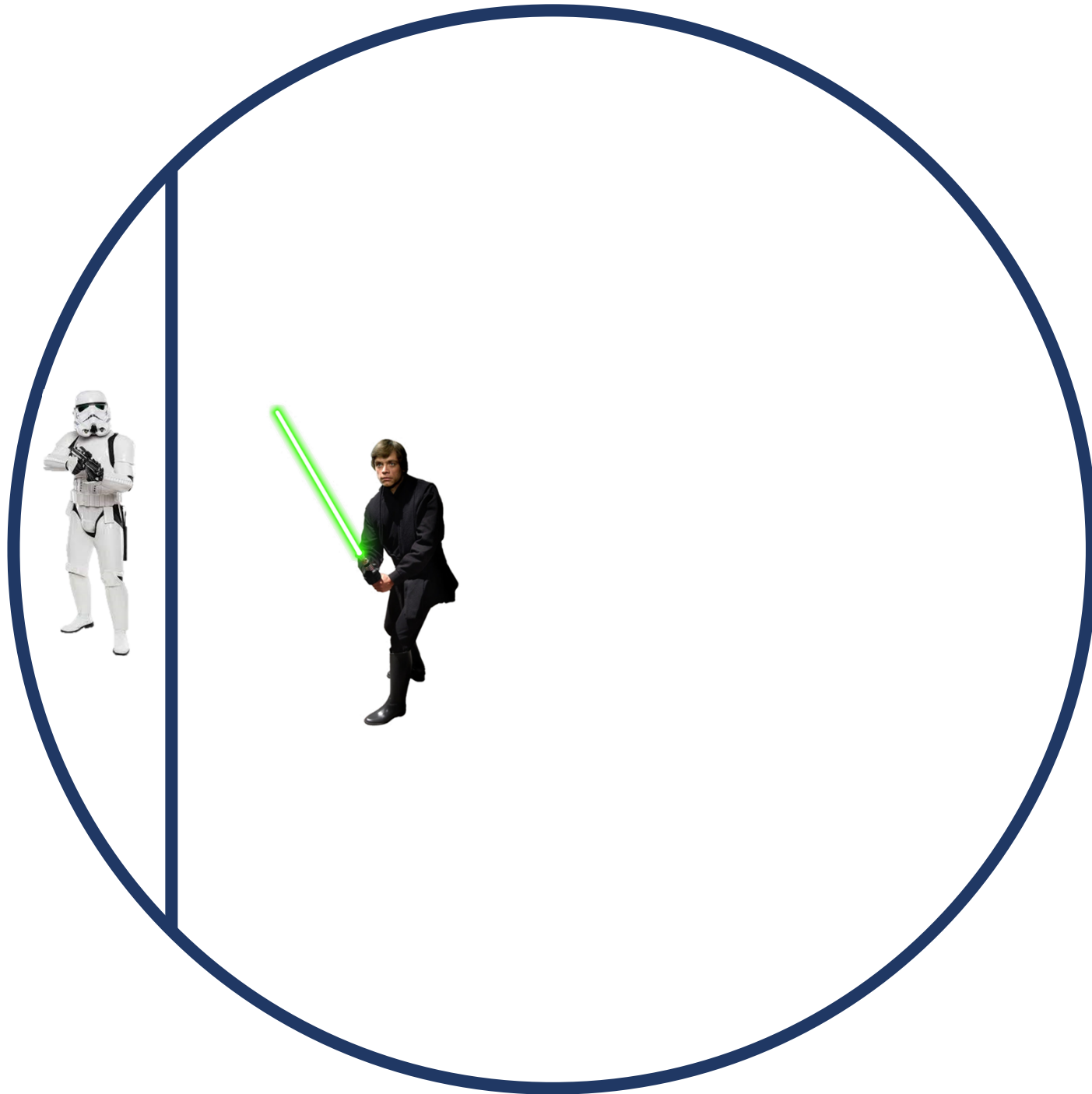
Glorification - eternal heavenly transformation
