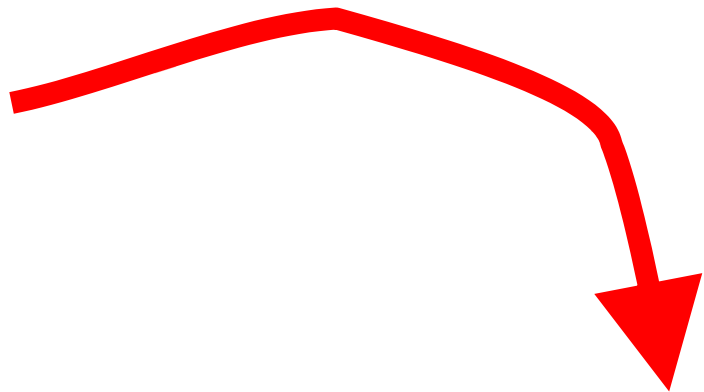

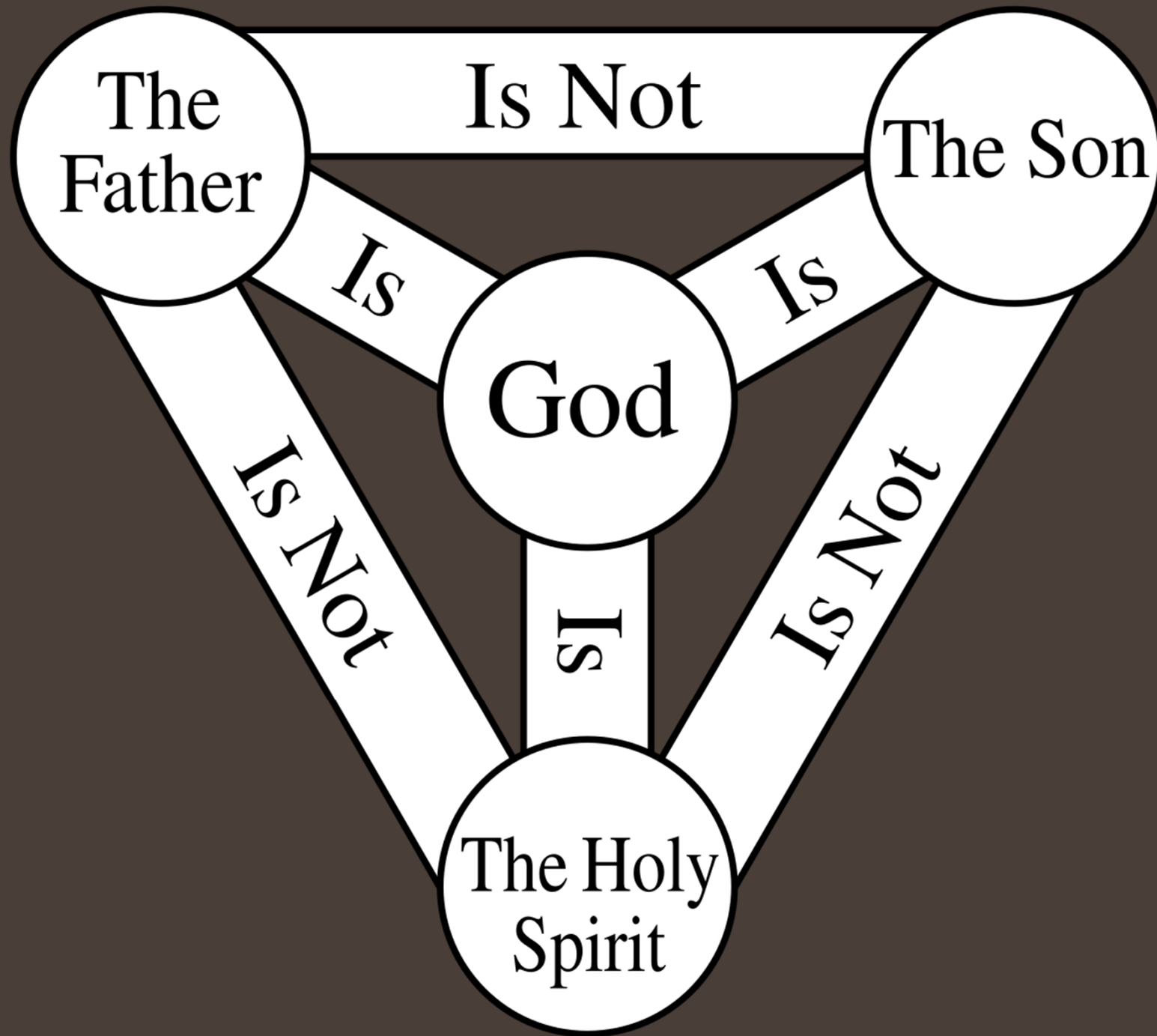

REVIEW GOD'S BEING:



- Infinite – limitless in size or scale; impossible to measure
- Unchangeable – solid and dependable
- Spirit – cannot be perceived by the physical senses
- Eternal – God has always and will always exist
- Omni – All powerful, All present, All knowing

Animated Dust

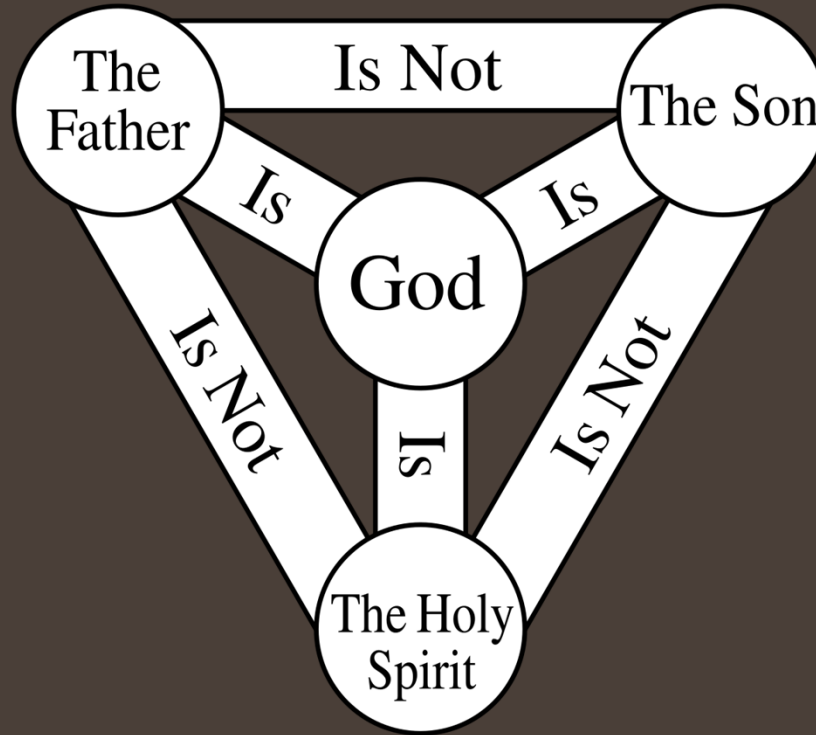
Psalm 104:29-30

The Battle

Galatians 5:17

For the flesh sets its desire against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; for these are in opposition to one another, so that you may not do the things that you please.

- The Flesh

Romans 7:18

For I know that nothing good dwells in me, that is, in my flesh; for the willing is present in me, but the doing of the good is not.

- The Spirit

1 Corinthians 6:19

Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own?

Victory in the Battle

- We control how we live!

Philippians 2:12-13

work out your salvation with fear and trembling; for it is God who is at work in you, both to will and to work for His good pleasure.

CLOSING

- The power is in the Holy Spirit
Galatians 5:16 But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not carry out the desire of the flesh.
- We are free from the power of sin
Romans 6:6 knowing this, that our old self was crucified with Him, in order that our body of sin might be done away with, so that we would no longer be slaves to sin
- Don't Present Yourself to Sin but to God
Romans 6:19 For just as you presented your members as slaves to impurity and to lawlessness, resulting in further lawlessness, so now present your members as slaves to righteousness, resulting in sanctification.
