Proverbs 31:10-31 TPT

“Who could ever find a wife like this one — she is a woman of strength and mighty valor! She’s full of wealth and wisdom.

The price paid for her was greater than many jewels.

Her husband has entrusted his heart to her, for she brings him the rich spoils of victory.

All throughout her life she brings him what is good and not evil.

She searches out continually to possess that which is pure and righteous.

She delights in the work of her hands.

She gives out revelation-truth to feed others.

She is like a trading ship bringing divine supplies from the merchant. Even in the night season she arises and sets food on the table for hungry ones in her house and for others.

She sets her heart upon a field and takes it as her own.

She labors there to plant the living vines.

She wraps herself in strength, might, and power in all her works.

She tastes and experiences a better substance, and her shining light will not be extinguished, no matter how dark the night.

She stretches out her hands to help the needy and she lays hold of the wheels of government.

She is known by her extravagant generosity to the poor, for she always reaches out her hands to those in need.

She is not afraid of tribulation, for all her household is covered in the dual garments of righteousness and grace.

Her clothing is beautifully knit together — a purple gown of exquisite linen.

Her husband is famous and admired by all, sitting as the venerable judge of his people.

Even her works of righteousness she does for the benefit of her enemies.

Bold power and glorious majesty are wrapped around her as she laughs with joy over the latter days.

Her teachings are filled with wisdom and kindness as loving instruction pours from her lips.

She watches over the ways of her household and meets every need they have.

Her sons and daughters arise in one accord to extol her virtues, and her husband arises to speak of her in glowing terms.

“There are many valiant and noble ones, but you have ascended above them all!” Charm can be misleading, and beauty is vain and so quickly fades, but this virtuous woman lives in the wonder, awe, and fear of the Lord.

She will be praised throughout eternity. So go ahead and give her the credit that is due, for she has become a radiant woman, and all her loving works of righteousness deserve to be admired at the gateways of every city!”

Key Aspects of the Proverbs 31 Woman

- **The Foundation is Fear of the Lord:** Her noble character isn't just about hard work; it stems from her devotion to God (v. 30), which provides her with wisdom, stability, and dignity.
 - This is the very foundation of her Identity, and you must know who you are in Christ to be the woman, wife, and mother that you are called to be.

Declarations

1. I am a beloved child of God (*1 John 3:1*)
2. I am the head and not the tail (*Deuteronomy 28:13*)
3. I am who God says I am, not what past experiences says I am.
4. I am the righteousness of Christ. (*2 Corinthians 5:21*)
5. I am strong and courageous (*Joshua 1:7*)

Proverbs Woman

- **Virtuous Character Over Performance:** The passage focuses on her noble character (v. 10), which is more valuable than jewels.
 - Instead of striving for wealth, power, success, and dominance like so many, She works with integrity, serves the poor, and gets stuff done. A life of noble character is a life of true success and happiness that can only come from the Lord.

Declarations

1. I am a person of consistent character and integrity.
 2. I make great choices that are in line with integrity and Godliness.
 3. I am the same person in public as I am in when I am alone.
 4. I do not make compromises for personal gain.
 5. People trust me because of how I live my life.
- **Diligent and Productive:** She is a hard worker who manages her household well, works with her hands, and engages in trade (v. 13-19).
 - Today's society most woman work in the home, raising kids, being a wife, and having a job is very busy lifestyle. We must be productive and very diligent with every moment we have.

Declarations

1. I am genuinely humble and kind.
 2. I am teachable and can learn something beneficial from all people.
 3. I am always looking for ways to serve others (Mark 10:43)
 4. I am able to rejoice when others are celebrated and promoted.
 5. I am humble but confident in who I am in Christ.
- **Generous and Wise:** She is not just focused on her own home; she extends her hands to the poor and needy (v. 20).
 - There is always a need and a woman's heart is always looking to serve and fill that need within the body of Christ.

Proverbs Woman

- There are many ways to give; Time and understanding, food, a hug to the hug-less, and smile to the one who can't smile for themselves.

Declarations

1. I am generous on every occasion (2 Corinthians 9:11)
 2. I am on a generosity rampage, seeking whom I can bless next.
 3. I have a unique ability to know when God is highlighting someone He is leading me to bless generously with time, money, or another resource.
 4. I always know what to do.
 5. I have the wisdom of God today for whatever I face. (*1 Corinthians 2:16*)
- **Strengthens Her Family:** She brings her husband good and not harm, making her husband a respected figure in the community (v. 11-12, 23).
 - A woman can only bring strength to her loved ones when she is coming from a place of strength in who she is in Christ Jesus.
 - You will know a man who has a Godly strengthening wife by his character and security in who he is.
 - Children will feel safe, protected, loved and led with a mom who gives strength to her family.

Declarations

1. Love never fails (*1 Corinthians 13:8*)
2. I see the good in others and call that out of them.
3. God's love is perfected in me. (*1 John 4:12*)
4. I inspire people when I speak.
5. I build up the people in my life with my words.

Worship team

- **Confident Future:** She "laughs at the time to come" (v. 25) because she is prepared and trusts in God.
 - A Godly woman, not only sees the future for herself, but for her family, she can see what her husband is capable of even if he cannot see it for himself and draws that out of him with wisdom and love.

- She can see the hand of God on her children and draws them into those things from the Lord.

Declarations

1. I have the spirit of power, love, and a sound mind.
2. I make good decisions that propel me and my family into there destiny.
3. My future is blessed because of the promises of God.
4. My ultimate purpose in life is to know Jesus and make him known.
5. I see my family's future through the lens of Hope through Jesus.
