How can we avoid being like the soldiers who came to arrest Jesus? Consider Deuteronomy 6:5-9 and John 8:31-32.

What do you think about Peter's actions when they arrested Jesus? Should we be like Peter, why or why not? Compare Matthew 11:28-29 with 2 Corinthians 12:9-10, and pray about how you respond.
