

Exodus 20: 12-17

*A son honors his father, and a servant his master. Then if I am a father, where is My honor? And if I am a master, where is My respect? (Malachi 1: 6)*

God says, "\_\_\_\_\_ - find out what it means to Me!"

*Respect* in Malachi 1 = Heb. "fear" = proper reverence and \_\_\_\_\_ to someone or some thing.

First 3 commandments all point to one thing: Respect \_\_\_\_\_!

The 4<sup>th</sup> commandment is to respect God by respecting the \_\_\_\_\_!

5. "Honor your father and your mother." In other words, "Respect your \_\_\_\_\_."

6. "Do not murder." In other words, "Respect human \_\_\_\_\_."

7. "Do not commit adultery." In other words, "Respect the sanctity of \_\_\_\_\_."

8. "Do not steal." In other words, "Respect other people's \_\_\_\_\_."

9. "Do not bear false witness." In other words, "Respect the \_\_\_\_\_."

*The Ten Commandments are the \_\_\_\_\_ possible standards of humane living. (Erwin McManus, An Unstoppable Force)*

10. "Do not covet." In other words, "Respect the boundaries of \_\_\_\_\_."

*Covet* in Ex. 20: 17 means "to be filled with inordinate, ungoverned, \_\_\_\_\_ desires."

Coveting is not just wanting my piece of the "pie." It means I want my piece of the pie, your piece of the pie...just give me the \_\_\_\_\_ pie!
