Holiness lost.

One day Cain suggested to his brother, "Let's go out into the fields." And while they were in the field, Cain attacked his brother, Abel, and killed him. Gen 4:8 NLT

How regret happens.

Genesis 3

The lie... If you break free from God, you'll gain something you don't have.

"You will not certainly die," the serpent said to the woman. 5 "For God knows that when you eat from it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil." Genesis 3:4,5

The truth... If you break free from God, you'll lose everything He has provided.

Then the man and his wife heard the sound of the Lord God as he was walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and they hid from the Lord God among the trees of the garden. Genesis 3:8

What we lost through sin can only be restored through Christ.

The Lord God made garments of skin for Adam and his wife and clothed them. Genesis 3:21
