Psalm 117

We praise God because of His love and faithfulness.

- "Praise the Lord, all nations! Extol him, all peoples! For great is his steadfast love toward us, and the faithfulness of the Lord endures forever. Praise the Lord!" -Psalm 117:1-2
- The writer of Psalm 117 is anonymous, we don't know who the author was, but we do get a look at the heart of God for all the nations to worship Him. This Psalm calls for the whole world to praise God.

Psalm 117 is part of a group of six songs sung as the Hebrews celebrate Passover and other important holidays.

- Psalms 113-118: known as the Egyptian Hallel.
- Psalm 114: A celebration of the children of Israel's Exodus out of Egypt.
