In difficult times, the temptation is to shrink your reach, but God wants us to stretch our faith and lengthen our reach.

"Enlarge the place of your tent, stretch your tent curtains wide, do not hold back; lengthen your cords, strengthen your stakes. ³ For you will spread out to the right and to the left; your descendants will dispossess nations and settle in their desolate cities. Isaiah 54:2-3

God sent Jesus to address humanity's ultimate issue...

This is how God showed his love among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him. ¹⁰ This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins. 1 John 4:9-10

Jesus sends us to take the good news that there is peace with God through Him... into all the world.

Again Jesus said, "Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am sending you." John 20:21

"... you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Acts 1:8

This is the message of Good News for the people of Israel—that there is peace with God through Jesus Christ, who is Lord of all. Acts 10:36 NLT

"See, the LORD your God has given you the land. Go up and take possession of it as the LORD, the God of your ancestors, told you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged." Deuteronomy 1:21

- Read Numbers 13:26-27, Deuteronomy 1:21-25. Pastor Gregg shared about the opportunity we have to purchase a church property. Dream a little...How would having a church home like this provide us an opportunity to lengthen our reach in Honolulu? Discuss with your group.
