- Read Acts 1:7-8. Discuss the difference between living 'safe' and living 'dangerous'. Where is God calling you to step out of 'safe living' and step into the adventure of living on mission with God?
- Read Acts 2:1, 42-47. Clifton and Pastor Gregg had a conversation about what can happen when Gospel, relationship and location intersect with each other. Discuss what can happen when relationship intersects with location. What could happen when location meets the Gospel?
- Dream a little with your group... How might a location for Grace Honolulu give us a place to more effectively gather, grow and go to the community?
