#### **Start Talking**

#### **Start Sharing**

- 1. Read Genesis 39:19-23 What do we notice about God? How did Josepha live in the tension that God was both with him and at the same time his circumstances were hard? What can we learn from this?
- 2. Think of person that you know who lives as if God is fully with them? What do you notice about that person? What might happen in your life if you fully believed that God was with you?
- *3. Read Genesis 25:27-34. What do you notice about the character of Jacob and Essau?*

- 4. Can you relate to Essau? Share a time when you've traded something valuable for something that means next to nothing?
- 5. Read Genesis 33:1-10 & 50:14-19. How are these two stories of forgiveness that play out in different generations similar? How does one impact the other?
- 6. How are you doing at modeling faith, hope, generosity or forgiveness in times of crisis for those around you on a scale of 1-10?
- 7. What principals or concepts do you hope to echo into the next generations of your family?
