boundaries produce different results? Share an example of this.

- 7. When we are unequally yoked, we end up going around in circles. Think of an equally yoked partnership. What fruit is evident from that relationship?*
- 8. Read the parable of the prodigal son (Luke 15:11-32). What does this show us about our Heavenly Father's heart?*
- 9. When have you seen someone "come to their senses" and step into act of repentance that changed their life?*
- 10. What might happen to your relationships and your ability to Love God and Love People if you leave the wrong place and move towards the Lord?*
