Key Scripture

Key Thoughts

You are not a body that has a soul. You are a soul that has a body.

What's most important in your life is not what you're doing but who you're becoming.

Trust = Worship

Removing False gods: (little g) 1. Identify the Idols of our Souls. 2. Tear them down.

3. Fill your Soul with God.

Start Talking

Check in with everyone: How's your soul?

Looking back at this week's message, what was a key thought you took away from it?

Start Thinking

Pastor Troy said what's most important is not what we're doing, but what we're becoming...Do you tend to see yourself more in terms of what you do or who you're becoming? Who are you becoming?

What are some ways we can identify the idols in our life?

What are some of the mud pies you have been feeding your soul?

In what ways are you experiencing the effect of those mud pies on your soul after the initial relief from the hunger/ thirst of your soul wears off?

What (or who) are you trusting/worshipping more than God? Where might you be misplacing your trust and worship?

Start Sharing

What areas of your life do you need to invite God into? entrust to God?

What are some different ways we can increase our focus on God? our trust in God?

In what ways is the Lord specifically inviting you to feast on Him? What action or shift is he inviting?

Start Praying

Pray that God would help us to see the idols in our life and the things/people we are putting before Him.

Start Doing

Be on the lookout this week for potential idols in your life. When you become aware of

an idol in your life, repent in prayer and action, tearing down the idol and repointing your life/trust/worship/focus toward God.
