

You Reap what you Sow The Law of the Harvest

Galatians 6:7-10

⁷Do not be deceived: **God is not mocked**, for whatever **one sows**, that will he **also reap**. ⁸For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life. ⁹And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up. ¹⁰ So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith. "

1. God will not be mocked
"For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, declares the Lord. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts." (Isaiah 55:8-9)
2. You only reap when you sow
"For here the saying holds true, 'One sows and another reaps.' I sent you to reap that for which you did not labor. Others have labored, and you have entered into their labor." (John 4 37-38)
3. You reap what you sow
"And God said, 'Let the earth sprout vegetation, plants yielding seed, and fruit trees bearing fruit in which is their seed, each according to its kind, on the earth.' And it was so." (Genesis 1:11)
"You will recognize them by their fruits. Are grapes gathered from thornbushes, or figs from thistles?" (Matt 7:16)
4. You will reap later than you sow
"Be patient, therefore, brothers, until the coming of the Lord. See how the farmer waits for the precious fruit of the earth, being patient about it, until it receives the early and the late rains." (James 5:7)
5. You reap more than you sow
"The point is this: whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. 7 Each one must give as he has decided in his heart, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver." (2 Cor 9:6-7)
6. You only reap more, when you take care of what was sown -
"I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth." (1 Cor 3:6)

7. You sometimes reap what others have sown

"For here the saying holds true, 'One sows and another reaps.' 38 I sent you to reap that for which you did not

labor. Others have labored, and you have entered into their labor." (John 4:37-38)
