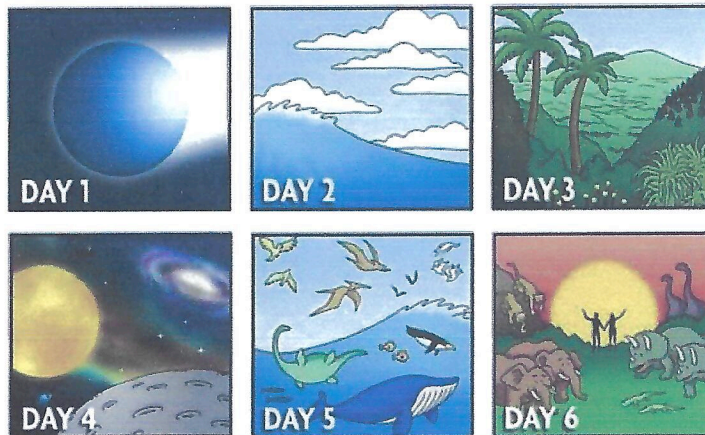




Genesis 1:24-31

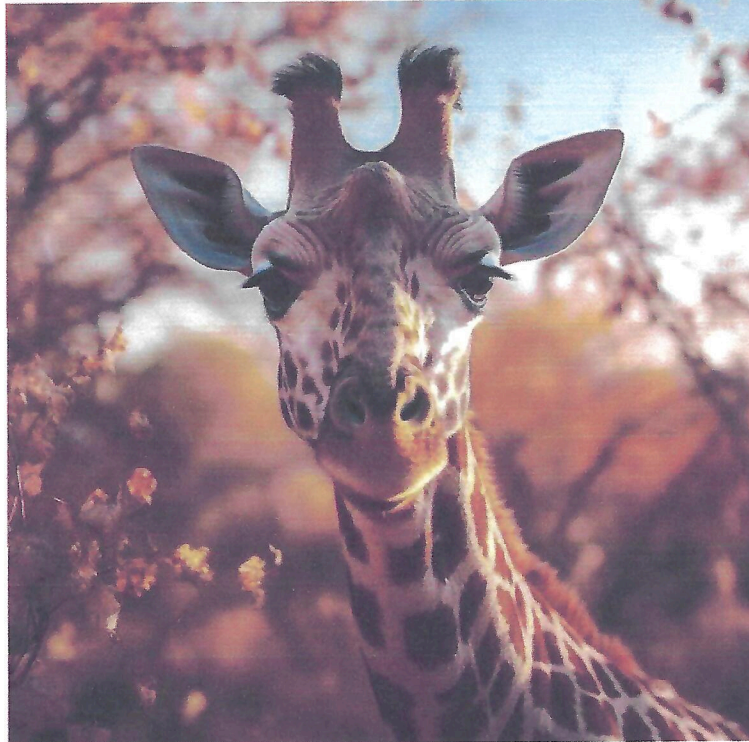

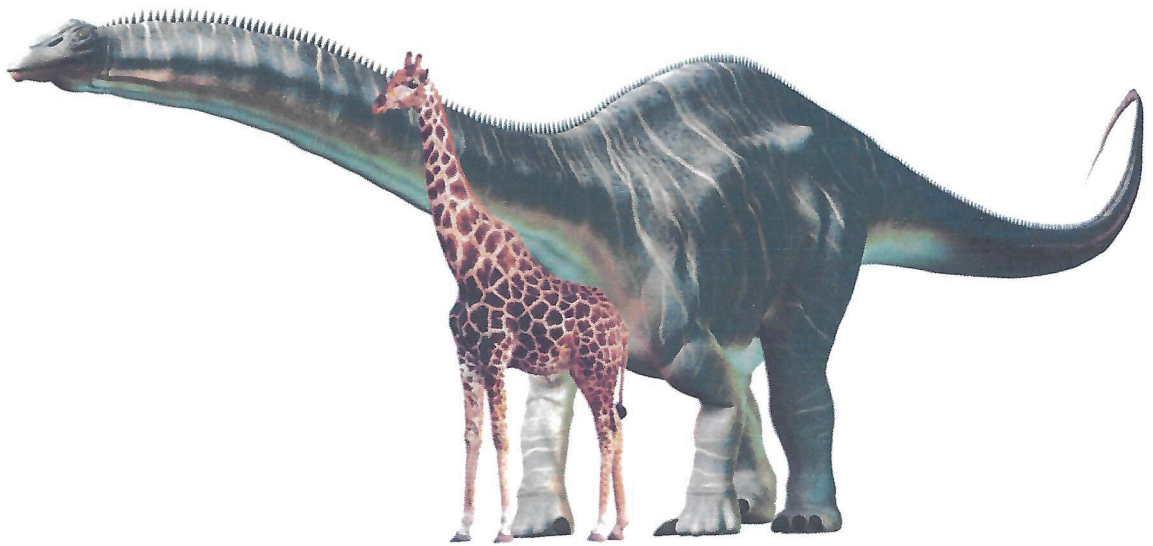


Brief Facts About Giraffes

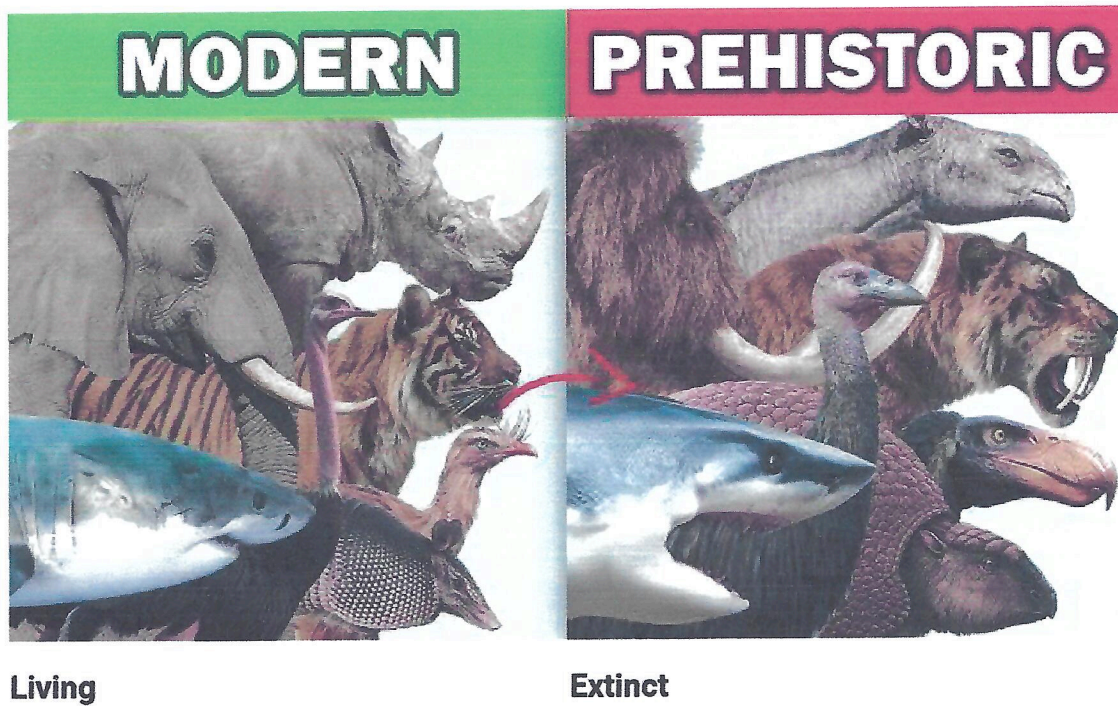
Giraffes are the **tallest living land animals**, with males reaching up to **18 feet (5.5 meters)** and females about **14 feet (4.5 meters)** They have **seven cervical vertebrae** like humans, but each is extremely long

Physical traits:

- **Ossicones** (horn-like structures) on their heads, more prominent in males
- **Prehensile tongues** up to 18 inches long, dark in color to protect from sunburn
- **Unique coat patterns** act like fingerprints, aiding camouflage and individual recognition (No two Patterns are the same).
- In short, giraffes are gentle giants with remarkable adaptations for their environment

The Platypus... the what??

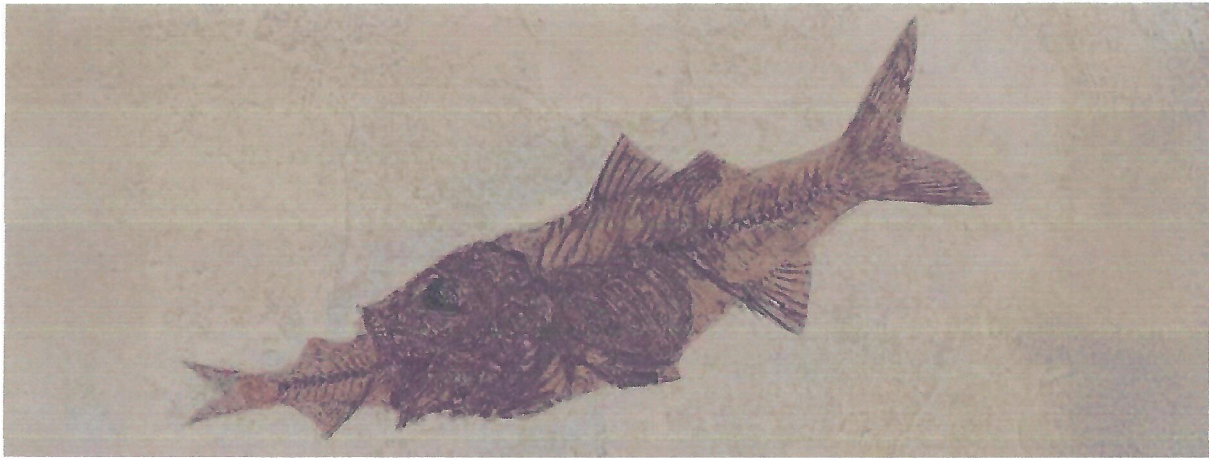


Here are 5 fascinating facts about the platypus:

- **They are egg-laying mammals:** Platypuses belong to a rare group of mammals called monotremes, they are one of only five surviving monotreme species in the world.
- **They hunt using electricity:** When diving, a platypus's eyes, ears, and nose are completely sealed, meaning they are functionally blind and deaf underwater. Instead, they hunt using thousands of electroreceptors in their duck-like bill, which can detect electrical impulses made by the muscles and nerves of their prey.
- **They sweat milk:** Female platypuses do not have nipples. When they nurse their young (known as *puggles*), they secrete milk directly through pores on their abdomen, and the babies simply lap or lick it up from the mother's skin and fur.
- **Males are venomous:** The platypus is one of the few venomous mammals in the world. Male platypuses have a sharp, hollow spur on each of their hind legs that can deliver a highly toxic, paralyzing venom—which they generally use during mating season to fight off rivals.

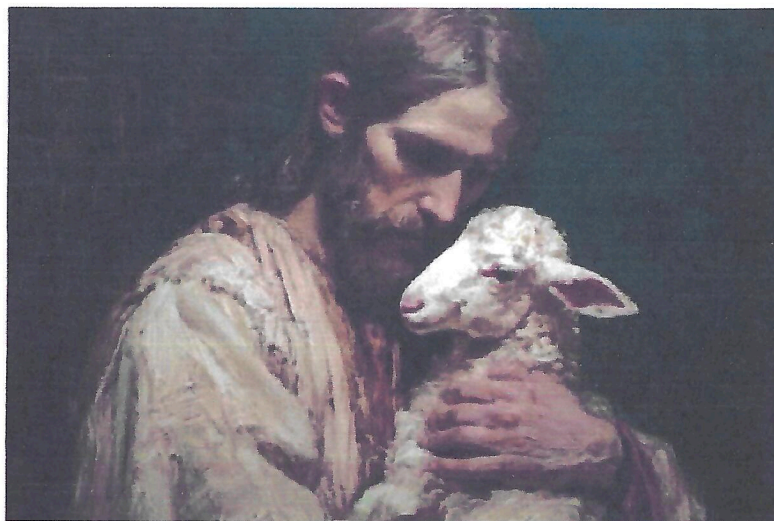
- **They glow under UV light:** When exposed to ultraviolet light, platypus fur absorbs the light and emits a distinct, biofluorescent blue-green glow. Scientists are still studying the trait but suspect it may help them see or identify each other at night.

Sheep

1. **Need for Direction:** Sheep have a poor sense of direction and easily get lost. Similarly, the Bible states that *"all we like sheep have gone astray,"* emphasizing that humans require God to guide their steps.
2. **Ultimate Vulnerability:** Sheep are virtually defenseless, lacking natural weapons like claws or sharp teeth. This illustrates our spiritual frailty and constant need for a divine protector.
3. **Not Built for Heavy Burdens:** Unlike donkeys or oxen, sheep are not load-bearing animals. This mirrors the human condition—we are not designed to carry the heavy loads of life's stresses, guilt, or worries by ourselves, but are encouraged to cast them upon God.
4. **Flock Mentality:** Sheep thrive in communities and are vulnerable when isolated. This reflects the importance of fellowship and unity within the human family, warning against the dangers of isolation.
5. **Recognizing the Voice:** Sheep learn to trust and follow only their specific shepherd's voice, fleeing from strangers. This mirrors how believers are called to discern, listen, and submit to God's voice over the noise of the world.

1 The Garden of Eden

(1) Thus the heavens and the earth, and all the host of them, were finished. (2) And on the seventh day God ended His work which He had done, and He rested on the seventh day from all His work which He had done. (3) Then God blessed the seventh day and sanctified it, because in it He rested from all His work which God had created and made.

(4) This is the [a]history of the heavens and the earth when they were created, in the day that the Lord God made the earth and the heavens, (5) before any plant of the field was in the earth and before any herb of the field had grown. For the Lord God had not caused it to rain on the earth, and there was no man to till the ground; (6) but a mist went up from the earth and watered the whole face of the ground.

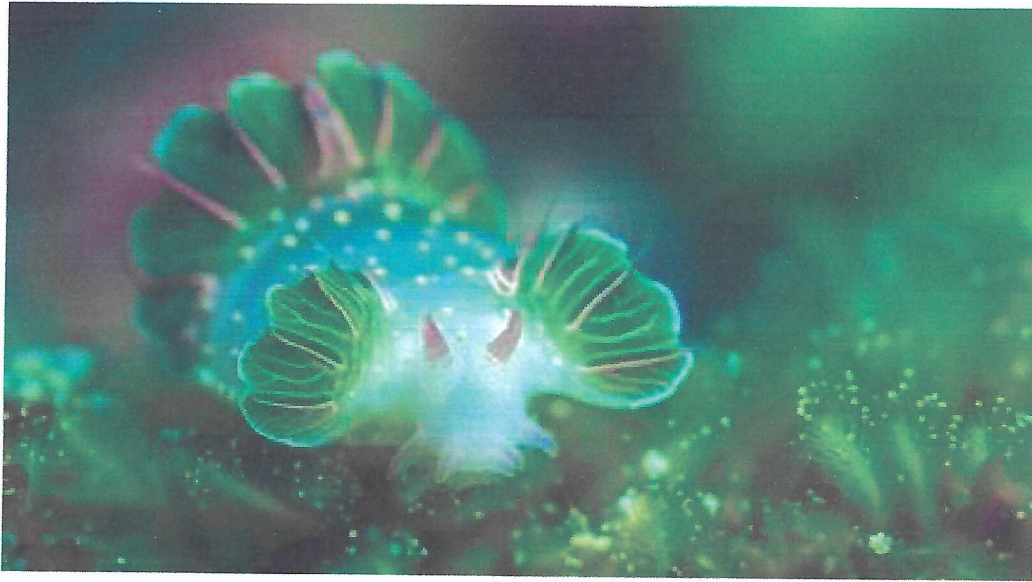
The Sea Sheep is Bio Luminescent!

Usually at depths of 30 to 60 feet is ideal to accommodate photosynthesis.

Feeding habits of the leaf sheep

This animal is one of the few that can perform photosynthesis. But they do it in an unusual way. Leaf sheep feed on algae, and in doing so, they also absorb algae's chloroplasts.

Then they use those chloroplasts to photosynthesize energy from light into food. The bushy, leaflike appendages all over their body contain the chloroplasts. Additionally, chloroplasts contain chlorophyll, so besides enabling photosynthesis, they also color this animal green. Thus, the body of this small creature looks like a coat of green leaves.




TOP VIEW (DORSAL SIDE)

Skin Subcutaneous Tissue Muscles Tendons Blood Vessels and Nerves Ligaments Bones




PALMAR VIEW (PALM SIDE)

Skin Muscles Tendons Blood Vessels and Nerves Ligaments Bones




SIDE VIEW (LATERAL)
