- a. They followed for free _____. Ek. 33:31; Rom. 16:18; Phi. 2:21; 3:19
 - i. The prosperity gospel. 1 Tim. 6:5
- b. They followed for another miracle. Acts 8:18-21
- c. They sought Jesus for what he could do for them. Mt. 6:33
 - i. Asking with selfish motives. Jas. 4:3
- d. They sought Jesus for a physical meal when he wanted to feed them spiritual food.
 - i. They are chasing what can never truly satisfy. Is. 55:1-2

II. The _____ (6:48-66)

- a. They do not understand that Jesus is speaking spiritually. 6:27, 35-36, 40-41, 63; Jn. 3
 - i. We must work (2 Tim. 2:15) to study comparing scripture with scripture (Is. 28:9-10) comparing spiritual with spiritual and physical with physical (1 Cor. 2:13).
- b. Even the 12 did not understand this saying.
 - i. That did not shake them.
 - ii. The Holy Spirit is our teacher. 1 Jn. 2:27; Jn. 14:26, 16:3; Lk. 24:45
- c. Jesus is trying to teach that he is the bread of _____. (vs 32-33, 35, 48, 51)
 - i. The Manna in the OT was not simply about the physical bread. Deut. 8:3
- d. Jesus parallels the _____
 - The manna came from Heaven
 - Jesus gives everlasting life
 - The manna had to be gathered
 - Jesus came from Heaven
 - Manna gave physical life temporarily
 - Jesus had to be received
