Marriage: The Struggle Between Two Sinners

Some sobering statistics:

- Half of Americans ages 18 and older were married in 2017, a share that has remained relatively stable in recent years but is down _____ percentage points since 1990. One factor driving this change is that Americans are staying single longer. The median age at first marriage had reached its highest point on record: 30 years for men and 28 years for women in 2018, according to the U.S. Census Bureau.
- As the U.S. marriage rate has declined, divorce rates have increased among older Americans. In 2015, for every 1,000 married adults ages 50 and older, 10 had divorced up from five in 1990. Among those ages 65 and older, the divorce rate roughly tripled since 1990.
- The number of U.S. adults cohabiting with a partner is on the rise. In addition to the half of U.S. adults who were married, 7% were cohabiting in 2016. The number of Americans living with an unmarried partner reached about ____million in 2016, up 29% since 2007. Roughly half of cohabiters are younger than 35 but cohabitation is rising most quickly among Americans ages 50 and older.
- Support for the legalization of same-sex marriage has grown in the past 10 years. In 2007, Americans opposed legalizing same-sex marriage by a margin of 54% to 37%. In 2017, more favored (_____%) than opposed (32%) allowing gays and lesbians to marry legally.

Biblical responsibilities of a husband	<u>Job</u>
He is to love his wife – Eph. 5:25.	Despite her poor advice and obviously harsh attitude, he does not speak or foolishly to her.
He is to know his wife – 1 Peter 3:7.	He knows this is not representative of her true character. (speakest AS).
He is to dwell with her – 1 Peter 3:7.	They have built a life together. He doesn't leave when things get tough.
He is to her – 1 Peter 3:7; 1 Tim. 5:3-17; Eph. 6:2.	He does not call her foolish. He does not get with her.
He is to provide for her – 1 Tim. 5:8.	She and her children have been well provided for.
He is to teach her – 1 Cor. 14:35.	He uses this tragedy as a teachable moment. Life is not always easy. God adversity.
He is to protect her – Eph. 5:23; Matt. 12:29; Pro. 18:10; 2 Sam 7.	He protects her from herself and from the Lord.

ABRAHAM AND SARAH

- He makes Sarah lie about being his wife to protect himself. He allows her to be taken into Pharaoh 's house Gen. 12:10-20.
- Sarah gives her handmaid to her husband to wed even after God promised that they would bear a child. (trying to force God's plan man's way) Gen. 16.
- He makes Sarah lie again about being his wife. God again protects her Gen. 20. (NOTE: 20:12 half-truth)
- Abraham fails at protecting his wife. They both fail at submitting to God's plan.

ISAAC AND REBEKAH

- She was hand-picked by God. No doubt that God wanted them to be husband and wife Gen. 24:1-15.
- Rebekah has a compassionate and servant's heart Gen. 24:18-20.
- She brought Isaac great comfort Gen. 24:67.
- Fast forward several years to a time where their children are grown. Rebekah hatches a plan to deceive her husband Isaac because she favors Jacob Gen. 27:1-40. (lie, cheat, steal)
- She again deceives Isaac to help Jacob while teaching him to run from his sin instead of repenting and seeking forgiveness Gen. 27:43-46.
- Rebekah fails at submitting, reverencing, and helping.

HOSEA AND GOMER

Hosea 1-3:

- God tells Hosea to marry a woman of whoredoms. She represents an unfaithful Israel and how God feels heart broken by their infidelity.
- They have three children, and then Gomer leaves him to play the whore once again.
- Heartbroken, Hosea searches the land for her, finds her, and restores her.
