Colossians 2 teaches the doctrinal truth that we are made complete in Jesus Christ and don't need anything else to be complete (2:10-14). Colossians 3 teaches us the practical daily way to walk complete in Him. We should desire every day to lay our lives down as a living sacrifice, die to that old person God saved us from (*our old man*), and put on the character of Jesus Christ who is in us giving us strength to do it (Php. 4:13). Our family units and societal roles all _____ from our daily walk and success in these things.
