Psalm 51 – Good Fruit from Sin??? Geoff Weaver 9/11/2024

There are two things in the introductory note to this Psalm that we need to remember: one, David wrote this after Nathan confronted him about his sin with Bathsheba and Uriah (2Sa 12:1-13). David was the king of Israel (a mighty and powerful man) but it took Nathan's intervention for David to deal with this problem. That sounds an awful lot like Galatians 6 to me: *ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness*... confrontation is rarely comfortable but is sometimes ______. Two, this is written to the chief musician...now we know that music and song are important to God and to us in our Christian life and we're going to take a cue from David and sing together at the end of the lesson.
