After receiving Jesus Christ as Savior, our main ______ remains to be the flesh in which we are still housed. A genuine Christian is supernaturally changed inside (Col. 2:10-14; 2 Cor. 5:17) and can find victory over the **dark hidden sins** (*fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness*) and the **surface level sins** (*anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy communication from our mouth, and lying*). Our victory is found through a Heavenly perspective, an internal choice to die daily to these things (*not trying harder*), and a daily renewal by putting on the character of Christ who is in us. **Our new man** must also practically be put on every day so He can rule the day (Gal. 5:16; Rom. 8:4).
