- Self-worth The world teaches our kids to base their self-worth on:
 - o their possessions (lust of the flesh).
 - their outside appearance (lust of the eyes)
 - o their accomplishments (pride of life)

Self-image:

- o The world tells our kids that they're not uniquely made, but that they're simply a result of a random combination of genes that's taken millions of years to create.
- The world convinces our kids that they are mere animals with physical desires that deserve to be met, and that sexual pleasure is just one of those desires that should be fulfilled without any emotional attachment.

1 John 2:16

- The world uses television and the media to promote certain body shapes as ideal over others.
 He convinces them that every measure must be taken to achieve these ideal body images, including those that lead to eating disorders and drug abuse.

OUR DEFENSE: TRAIN UP

- It is first important to remember where our children come from Psalm 127:3.
 - Heritage In Scripture, the saints or people of God are called his heritage, as being claimed by him, and the objects of his special care. Something transmitted by or acquired from a predecessor.
 Ex. 6:8; Ps. 119:111; 1 Peter 5:3.

 - Heritage is what you receive, legacy is what you _____ Ps. 78:4, 145:4; Joshua 4:21-22; Deut. 6:6-7; Eph. 6:4.
 - Reward a blessing directly from God! A chance to carry on a godly legacy. (think how important this was/is to the Jew!)
- The Bible uses an interesting simile for children and how parents are to "handle" them: "as arrows" Psalm 127:4.
 - o Bow = God & Word of God.
