

This letter of Colossians was written by Paul, God's apostle to the Gentiles, to the newly established churches at Colosse and Laodicea located in modern day Turkey (1:2, 2:1, 4:13-16). Paul had never been there but taught these early Christians about the fulness of Jesus Christ (*His will, their status and standing in Him, His preeminence in all things, and His reconciling work through the cross*). Chapter two zoned in on their ______ in Jesus Christ (2:10) versus the **external** and **internal** conflicts that would come against genuine Christianity (*enticement, philosophy, deceit, traditions, rudiments of the world, and religion*). In this third chapter, Paul expounds on the realities of our two homes and our own personal internal struggle.
