b. Humanity is deceived though _____ – vs. 2-3

- If you are relying on your own goodness to stand before God, you're in for a shameful reality when stand before Him – Job 14:4, 40:4, 42:5-6; Psalm 14:1-3, 53:1-3; Ecclesiastes 7:20, 29; Isaiah 6:5, 53:6, 64:6; Jeremiah 4:22; Micah 7:2; Matthew 19:17; Romans 3:12, 7:18, 24; 1 Peter 2:25
- There is profit in your goodness and willingness to be a vessel of His righteousness, but it's only profitable down here. – John 15:5; Philippians 3:9; Galatians 6:10; Ephesians 3:14-15

c. Humanity is destroyed through _____ – vs. 4; Jeremiah 7:16-20; 2 Peter 2:1

- We don't have God's preserved Word – Psalm 12:6-7
- You need to confess your sins to a man – 1 Timothy 2:5
- You have no choice in the matter of salvation – Romans 10:13
- Jesus' blood only covered or paid for the elect's sins – 1 John 2:2
- There are certain sacraments, works, or traditions that must be done to maintain your salvation – Ephesians 2:8-9
- Baptism is necessary for salvation – 1 Corinthians 1:17
- Salvation is associated with tongues, signs, or healing gifts – 1 Corinthians 13:8-13
- Jesus Christ is not God – Philippians 2:6
