We continue through a controversial section of the book of Jonah exploring Jonah's otherworldly journey in the whale to Hell and back (v. 2, 6). Our focus today will be on the very horrific location the Bible describes as Hell. We will go with Jonah to Hell for a look at it through the eyes of Scripture. There are those who speak lightly about this biblical place quipping things like "Heaven for the climate, Hell for the company!...See you in Hell!...Party in Hell, meet you there," yet the Bible paints a very different reality about it (Is. 28:14-18). We will seek to gain a firm understanding of the realities of this place called Hell.
