	(G	en. 17:20)?
	•	God promises to bless and multiply Abraham's seed bringing forth a great nation when he was 75 years old. Abraham God would do it – Gen. 12:1-4, 15:1-6; Rom. 4:17-18.
	•	Eleven years pass with no heir and Abraham and Sarah panic and move ahead of God, their lives and God's promise, bringing Ishmael into the world illegitimately – Gen. 16:1-12, 15-16.
	•	God blesses Ishmael and his lineage (<i>Arab nations</i>) in answer to Abraham's, because he is Abraham's seed, and because He cares for Ishmael – Gen. 17:15-22; 21:13-21; Ps. 68:4-5; Ja. 1:27.
	•	There is a bigger practical/devotional lesson from this story about doing things in the flesh vs. the Spirit/power of God – Gal. 4:21-26, 28-31.
2.		d says "it was so" when He finishes Day 2 of creation (Gen. 1:7), but on every other creative day ends by saying "it was good" or "very good." Why was Day 2 different?
	•	God finishes all but Day 2 of the creative days with the "goodvery good" phrase. Every word of God matters, and God is, so this difference stands out – Gen. 1:4, 10, 12, 18, 21.
	•	On Day 2, God establishes the firmament of the Heavens, a three-fold heavenly structure. He the existing water above the firmament of the heavens and below it. The sun, moon, and stars are inside this firmament (or division) – Gen. 1:1-2, 6-8, 14-16, 20; Ps. 148:1-4; 2 Cor. 12:2.
	•	On Day 2, it appears that God creates a temporary of separation between His Heaven above and man's dwelling below on Earth which is not necessarily "good," but "it was so" for the time being – Is. 66:1; Job 9:4-8; 26:7-12; 38:8-11, 30; Rev. 4:1-6.
	•	This sea of separation is after the Millennium (1000-year reign of Christ on Earth) when the devil and sin are eradicated. God then dwells openly with man and His creation – Rev. 21:1-5.
