

# Waiting on the Lord

# Psalm 27:14 - Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the LORD.

WAIT - To \_\_\_\_\_\_ or rest in expectation; to stop or remain *stationary*, till the arrival of some person or event.

<u>WAIT ON</u> - To \_\_\_\_\_, as a servant; to perform menial services for. To pay servile or submissive attendance. To *follow*. To look watchfully or to watch. To wait for something to happen before you do or decide something.

## Key Elements of Waiting ON the Lord – Psalm 27

#### **TRUST** - v. 1-3

- It's personal: "my". Trust=confidence -v3. Mature faith. From believing to \_\_\_\_\_\_.
- Experience brings trust (v2-3).
- Trust has no \_\_\_\_\_\_ Rom. 8:31; 2 Tim. 1:7.
- EXAMPLES:

### ACTION - v4

- "That will I seek" opposite of wait but same as wait on Pro. 2:1-9.
- "Dwell" communion with God & other believers.
- "Enquire" to seek truth by asking questions or by \_\_\_\_\_\_.
  - o Matt. 7:7-8. <u>A</u>sk. <u>Seek. K</u>nock.
- EXAMPLES:

#### **PRAYER** - v7,11-13

- David prays for \_\_\_\_\_ v11
- David prays for \_\_\_\_\_ v12
- David believed his prayer would be answered v13 (it kept him waiting on the Lord)
- All leading to this conclusion: WAIT ON THE LORD.

**<u>KEY POINT</u>**: Always wait ON God while you wait \_\_\_\_\_\_ Him.
