In Jonah 2, we enter a very messy part of the story. He has just been cast overboard, by his own approval, for the salvation of the mariners who are left on the ship alive. He is then swallowed up by a great fish and taken into the \_\_\_\_\_ sea (v. 3). We will now see two great controversies of Jonah's story. Was Jonah swallowed by a great fish or by a whale...and did he die or did he yet remain alive inside of this creature? Religious people bicker about both questions (Matt. 23:23-24) and the lost world uses these controversies to disregard all the truth of the Bible. Is there a purpose to Bible controversy and can we know the truth?
