	-	Making proper judgments towards people and situations <b>always starts</b> with looking inwardly and judging ourselves before making any judgments about others – v. 1-5; Luke 12:57; John 7:24; 1 Cor. 2:15, 6:1-4, 11:13-16, 26-32.

	-	We are to use extra caution when interacting with unbelievers, false teachers, and those who have strayed away from the truth $-$ v. 6; Mark 15:1-5; John 18:33-38; Rom. 16:17; Pr. 26:4-5.

	-	When searching for Heaven's perspective on decisions, judgments, and directionwe are to <b>ask</b> , <b>seek</b> , and sometimes <b>knock</b> – v. 7-11.

	-	A final rule ("golden rule") to guide us with others is to put ourselves in their shoes as we interact. Consider where they are in their life and perspective – v. 12; John 16:12; Rom. 15:1-3; Php. 2:3-5.

	-	Strait = Close; tight; strict; rigorous; a sense of straining and is associated.
