1.	He	eaven's Perspective on our Treasures – v. 19-24
	-	Earthly treasures ALL corrupt (<i>wear down</i> /) and are laid up in main categories of clothes (<i>moths</i>), vehicles (<i>rust</i>), and houses (<i>thieves</i>) – Acts 2:27; Heb. 1:10-12; Luke 12:16-21; Job 21:13.
	-	Heavenly treasures ARE incorruptible (<i>do not wear down/decay</i>) and are laid up in Heaven for our future – v. 20; 1 Cor. 15:51-53; 1 Pet. 1:3-4, 23; 2 Cor. 4:6-7, 17-18; 1 Cor. 3:11-15.
		The Crowns of Heaven ✓ Crown of Righteousnessfor those who long for the appearing of Jesus Christ – 2 Tim. 4:8 ✓ Crown of Lifefor those who suffer, endure, or die for Jesus Christ – James 1:12; Rev. 2:10 ✓ Crown of Incorruptionfor living a life of balance, moderation, and self-control – 1 Cor. 9:25 ✓ Crown of Rejoicingfor those we helped to be saved/discipled to grow – 1 Thess. 2:19-20 ✓ Crown of Gloryfor being a shepherd (leader) of God's people in some way – 1 Pet. 5:1-4
	-	Our earthly vs. heavenly treasure pursuits/focus are mutually exclusive and either pursuit/focus can easily become all Also, these opposing life pursuits are a love-hate relationship – v. 21-24; Pr. 28:22; Ezek. 8:7-12; James 5:1-3; Pr. 23:4; 1 Tim. 6:17-18.
2.	He	eaven's Perspective on our Needs and Worries – v. 25-34
	-	God is aware of all our physical (food, drink, clothing) and promises to supply them without our worrying like the rest of the world (Gentiles) – v. 11, 27, 32; Luke 10:41-42; Ps. 37:25; Php. 4:19
		 ✓ Behold the fowls of the air (v. 26) – ✓ Consider the lilies (and grass) of the field (v. 28, 30) – Ps. 103:15-16; Is. 40:6-8; 1 Pet. 1:24
	-	This is the first mention in the Bible about the Kingdom of God (<i>spiritual kingdom inside</i>). We are to put our efforts toward spiritual things believing God's promise that He will take care of all our physical needs – v. 33; Luke 17:20-21 (<i>within</i>); Rom. 14:17 (<i>spiritual</i>); John 4:34 (<i>sustaining</i>).
	-	Our main worry and focus should be on issues. There are enough troubles needing our attention today without borrowing from tomorrow's troubles – v. 34; Php. 4:6-8.
